Other than that we always ask for your prayers for the health and safety for the children and teachers and the strength and patience to let Jesus "work through us" as we minister to His precious children.

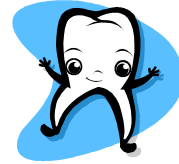


## Flowers Calendar for 2012

## Child Dental Health

Healthy teeth are an important part of children's overall health. Forming good habits at a young age can help children have healthy teeth for life.



Check your baby's teeth. Healthy teeth should be all one color. If you see spots or stains, take your baby to the dentist. Clean your baby's teeth daily using a soft clean cloth or a baby's toothbrush.

Don't put a baby to bed with a bottle. Milk, formula, juice, and other drinks have sugar in them. Sugary liquids left on a baby's teeth for too long can lead to tooth decay.

At age two, start using a small amount of fluoride toothpaste on your child's toothbrush. Young children cannot get their teeth clean by themselves. Children need help brushing until they are seven or eight years old. Help them brush their teeth first and then let them finish.

Feed your child healthy food. Choose foods without a lot of sugar in them. Give your child fruits and vegetables for snacks. Save cookies and other treats for special occasions.

Remember...

- Brush teeth regularly
- Provide healthy foods and limit sweet snacks and drinks
- Provide low-fat milk and dairy products high in calcium
- Schedule regular dental check-ups

You don't have to brush your teeth – Just the ones you want to keep.

# The Beauty of God's Design

*"He has made everything beautiful in its time." (Eccl. 3:11, NIV)*

Consider for a moment something beautiful that you admire...a piece of artwork or architecture, a glorious sunrise or sunset, a newborn baby, a snow capped mountain, a trickling brook, a well articulated poem, a compassionate word or action, a gifted athlete, or even a splendidly adorned table.

What do they all have in common?

Each has been crafted carefully, prepared and ordered lovingly. Each brush stroke fitly placed, every angle thoughtfully configured, all aspects designed by their creator and intentionally focused to bring joy to their world.

Those who purposely embrace their call to holiness and faithfulness are beautiful reflections of the God who created them for His glory, praise and joy. But, as John Stott once wrote, "Holiness is not a condition into which we drift."

Therefore a holy life is not something that comes naturally to any of us. A holy and devout life is one that we choose. As a result we become children of God who respond to God's loving initiatives by our daily intentionality toward faithfulness – and in so doing fulfill our Creator's design.

Your holy life...becoming someone beautiful for God...is not a life we drift toward, but instead a life we choose in and by His mercy. Lean in to God's loving embrace and wisely order (and then continuously re-order) your heart according to His wisdom, grace, forgiveness and truth. God delights to show you his pathway toward a beautiful, holy life.

So, practically, how do we choose a path of holiness? What can we intently engage that will direct us toward faithfulness? I want to encourage you to explore one of the Christian formation opportunities that begin this month at First Covenant.
