REFLECTIONS: Mary Andrews

1 Timothy 1-6

Paul opens his letter with a beautiful bold description of himself: a man who is commanded by God to be an apostle of Jesus. As followers of Jesus, should we all introduce ourselves this way? Because we are both disciples (students of Jesus) as well as apostles (called to share the gospel). It's who we each are called to be.

Paul's words are filled with instruction, wisdom, and guidance. He shows us what to look for in our church leaders; how we should conduct ourselves; how to show love, respect, and care for one another. And all this begins with the foundation of truth.

There were false teachers in Paul's day, and we still have them. Unless we know God's truth; we can't recognize the false teachers when they come. Paul encourages me to be strong and follow God's truth by turning from the things that don't bring me closer to God. I have to continue to hold tight to the eternal life that God called me to. In those times when I stumble, I have the promise of Jesus: He will never leave or forsake me. Because I am His.

THE DUGOUT: A Place For Kids & Their Families August 03: 1 Timothy 1-6

In 1 Timothy 2, Paul says this: "The first thing I want you to do is pray. Pray every way you know how, for everyone you know. Pray especially for rulers and their governments to rule well so we can be quietly about our business of living simply, in humble contemplation. This is the way our Savior God wants us to live."

Grab a big piece of paper or tape smaller pieces of paper together to create a prayer wall. Throughout the week, write names of people you are praying for. Draw pictures of people or places you care about. Ask God to show you how God is at work in these places. Write a note or call some of the people you are praying for... even those in government or leadership positions. Maybe your principal needs a note of encouragement this week? Or your neighbor?
