Global 6K

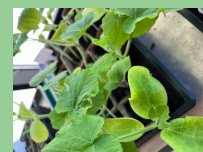
May 18th - 9:00 AM

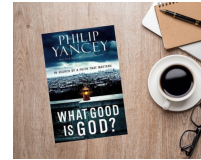
Grow with FCC

Check out the growing seedlings in the Upper Commons at FCC. The tables are full of tomatoes, beans and zinnias! Soon these plants will be ready to share.



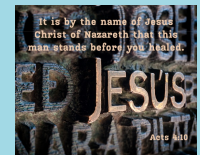
From the Pastor's Desk
