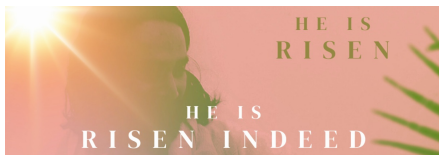
May 2nd-4th - Young Adult Retreat
